### **Food at School**

In Australia, students have to take food to school or buy it at the school tuckshop.

Schools have two breaks between class.
Students can eat lunch and snacks in these breaks.

It's good to bring food and drinks from home.

# How to order food and drinks from the tuckshop

Choose your child's order from the tuckshop menu


Write your child's name, class and order on a brown paper bag

Put money inside the bag to pay for the order





Give the brown paper bag to the tuckshop before school starts

Ask your teacher or tuckshop staff how to buy food and drinks at your school.

# How to buy food and drinks from the tuckshop

At break time, line up at the counter

Look at the menu and choose what you would like

Ask the staff for the food and drinks you would like.
Remember to say please and thank you



Use your money to pay for your food and drinks

At some schools you can pay with bank cards



### **Every school is different!**

Check with your teacher or tuckshop staff what happens at your school.

For example, some schools let you choose food and drinks and pay before school starts. Then you just pick up your order at break time.
